

### *Fraud Policy*

In accordance with the State's policy statement on fraudulent practices, all State agencies, employees, vendors, contractors, outside agencies, or persons employed by or doing business with the State or in any other relationship with the State shall adhere to the highest standards of ethical conduct; respect the public trust and the rights of all persons; be open, accountable, and responsive; avoid any appearance of impropriety; not use their position for private or personal gain; and prevent, identify and report any appearances of fraud and or corruption that is observed during the conduct of any business by or with the State of Rhode Island.
