CLASS DEFINITION:

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES: To perform the professional duties and services of a hairdresser and cosmetician in the care and treatment of the hair, scalp, skin, nails and eyebrows; and to do related work as required.

<u>SUPERVISION RECEIVED:</u> Works under the general supervision of a superior, with wide latitude for independent action in the performance of professional duties; work is occasionally reviewed after completion for general appearance and satisfaction of results.

<u>SUPERVISION EXERCISED:</u> May instruct and supervise patient or other help assigned to assist in nonprofessional duties.

ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK PERFORMED:

To perform the professional duties of a hairdresser and cosmetician.

To shampoo and cleanse the hair and scalp.

To cut and thin hair.

To give scalp treatments.

To give facials.

To give marcel waves, finger waves and permanent waves.

To comb and style waves after drying.

To dye and bleach hair.

To give manicures.

To remove superfluous hair.

To manage a beauty shop, requisitioning and maintaining equipment and supplies.

To do related work as required.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT:

KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS AND CAPACITIES: A thorough knowledge of the theory and practice of hairdressing and cosmetic treatments; skill in hairdressing and cosmetic treatments; the ability to use, maintain and care for standard equipment and supplies of hairdressers and cosmeticians; the ability to exercise judgement, alertness, and care in dealing with various institutional patients; and related capacities and abilities.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

<u>Education</u>: Such as may have been gained through: completion of a standard course of instruction in an approved school of hairdressing and the required practice in hairdressing and cosmetics to qualify for a full three year license in Rhode Island; and

<u>Experience</u>: Such as may have been gained through: employment as a full licensed hairdresser and cosmetician. <u>Or</u>, any combination of education and experience that shall be substantially equivalent to the above education and experience.

<u>SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:</u> Must be a full licensed hairdresser and cosmetician holding a three year license in Rhode Island, or must obtain such license before appointment and maintain such licensure as a condition of employment.
