



- To maintain external and indwelling catheters.
- To assist nurses during emergencies.
- To exchange large O<sub>2</sub> tanks, refill small O<sub>2</sub> tanks.
- To move trash when applicable to the dumpster and linen to linen receptacles.
- To apply braces to limbs prosthetic appliances.
- To assist in evacuation of the facility during a fire emergency.
- To transport patients to appointments or therapies in the building.
- To participate in unit staff meetings.
- To utilize state of the art electronic equipment to record data in patients' records with appropriate training.
- To do related work as required.

## **REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT:**

**KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND CAPACITIES:** A familiarity with the practices involved in patient care, including those relating to first aid, housekeeping, and personal needs; a familiarity with the practices involved in the care and custody of persons admitted or committed to a state institution for care and treatment; ability to participate in care and development programs for people with an intellectual and developmental disability; ability to learn and to perform a variety of routine hospital tasks involved in the care and custody of such persons; the ability to understand and carry out simple oral and written instructions; and related capacities and abilities.

## **EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:**

Education: Sufficient to ensure ability to read, write, and speak English; and

Experience: Such as may have been gained through: employment involving the opportunity to gain a familiarity with routine hospital or institutional procedures.

Or, any combination of education and experience that shall be substantially equivalent to the above education and experience.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:** At the time of appointment must be registered as a Certified Nursing Assistant by the Rhode Island Department of Health per the General Laws of Rhode Island and must maintain such registration as a condition of employment.

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
