CLASS DEFINITION:

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES: To be responsible for the regulation of applicable motor carrier related statutes, rules and regulations; and to do related work as required.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED: Works under the supervision of the Associate Administrator for Motor Carriers and Highway Freight Carrier Examiner.

SUPERVISION EXERCISED: Usually none.

ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK PERFORMED:

To be responsible for the regulation of applicable motor carrier related statutes, rules and regulations.

To explain procedures to be followed in publishing tariff schedules to be filed with the Division.

To determine if proposed tariffs are just reasonable and compensatory.

To assist in the regulation of tariff schedules posted by motor carriers under the provisions of Rhode Island State Law.

To assist in the investigations to determine certified carriers compliance with the Rhode Island Laws, rules and regulations.

To assist in maintaining cooperative relations with carrier authorities in adjacent states.

To assist with road checks to determine if motor carriers have proper licenses and certificates.

To assist in investigating and resolving complaints against regulated motor carriers.

To do related work as required.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT:

KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS AND CAPACITIES: A thorough knowledge of the laws governing the regulation of motor carriers; a working knowledge of the policies and procedures of the Interstate Commerce Commission; the ability to prepare written reports; the ability to gather and evaluate evidence and make recommendations; the ability to maintain and establish effective working relationship with motor carrier officials, superiors and the general public; and related capacities and abilities.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

Education: Such as may have been gained through: graduation from a college of recognized standing; and

Experience: Such as may have been gained through: employment in a responsible capacity with a governmental agency involving the regulation of motor carriers.

Or, any combination of education and experience that shall be substantially equivalent to the above education and experience.
