

**CLASS TITLE: PARK CONSTRUCTION AND
REPAIR SUPERVISOR**

CLASS DEFINITION:

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES: To supervise the work of a staff engaged in the performance of special construction, repair and maintenance duties in a park, roadside picnic area, or other areas or sites in the State Park System; and to do related work as required.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED: Works under the general supervision of the Deputy Chief of the Division from whom are received general and specific directions and instructions; work is reviewed in process or upon completion.

SUPERVISION EXERCISED: Supervises and reviews the work of semi-skilled or unskilled laborers.

ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK PERFORMED:

In a park, roadside picnic area, or in other areas or sites in the State Park System, to supervise the work of a staff engaged in the performance of special construction, repair and maintenance duties such as: constructing, altering, maintaining, and repairing park buildings and structures, bathhouses, sheds, shelters, board walks, picnic tables and fire places, sled slides, stages, ski tows and snow making equipment, recreational and sports areas and facilities, water and toilet drainage systems, and other structures or facilities within the State Park System.

To do related work as required.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT:

KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS AND CAPACITIES: A working knowledge of the methods and practices used in the construction, alteration, maintenance and repair of park buildings and structures, skiing and skating equipment and facilities, picnic area structures and facilities, parking areas, water and toilet drainage systems; the ability to supervise the work of a staff engaged in the performance of the above described duties; and related capacities and abilities.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

Education: Such as may have been gained through: completion of eight school grades; and

Experience: Such as may have been gained through: employment as a supervisor in charge of a crew engaged in construction or maintenance work.

Or, any combination of education and experience that shall be substantially equivalent to the above education and experience.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: At the time of appointment must be physically qualified to perform assigned duties as evidenced by a physician's certificate.
