**CLASS DEFINITION:**

**GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES:** To operate various sewer cleaning motor driven machines; to perform a variety of manual tasks which require general mechanical aptitude; and to do related work as required within the wastewater collection system.

**SUPERVISION RECEIVED:** Assignments are laid out in general and specific terms by a superior; work is reviewed while in process and upon completion.

**SUPERVISION EXERCISED:** May supervise one or more Collection System Operator I and II specifically assigned to assist.

**ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK PERFORMED:**

To perform a variety of manual tasks of more than ordinary difficulty or responsibility requiring general mechanical aptitude, ability and experience approaching the requirements of skilled trades.

To assist in repairing and constructing catch basins, manholes, sewers and stone walls, curbing, drains, and other appurtenant structures.

To assist in setting wood sheeting associated with trench work and constructing concrete forms associated with building or repairing appurtenant collection system structures.

To assist in the repair of inlets, regulators, tide gates, sumps, pumping stations, metering stations, and sewer screens.

To inspect, monitor, maintain and clean sewer lines, catch basins, sumps, regulators, pumping and metering stations and sewer screens using whatever hand or motor driven tools deemed proper for the purpose.

To operate various sewer cleaning motor driven machines, i.e. diggers, "Vac-All" type cleaners, flushers, bucket machines and rodding machines, etc.

To operate motor driven equipment, i.e. pumps, compressors and generators.

To drive a truck and to place and collect safety signs on roads.

To assume a certain responsibility for the proper functioning of motor driven machines, equipment and the trucks on which these machines may be mounted and to indicate to superior any problems with such machines requiring maintenance or repair.

To assist in cleaning and painting structures and equipment.

To assist Grade III Operator when necessary.

To do related work as required.

**REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT:**

**KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS AND CAPACITIES:** A working knowledge of the routine methods and techniques (less than the journeyman level) applied in maintenance trades and occupations; the ability to operate motor driven equipment; the ability to apply such methods and techniques at a level less than a journeyman worker; the ability to understand and follow oral or written instructions; and related capacities and abilities.

**EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:**

Education: Such as may have been gained through: completion of eight school grades; and

Experience: Such as may have been gained through: employment in semi-skilled manual labor and operating machinery or motor driven equipment in the construction and maintenance of roads, bridges, buildings and sewers or employment as a WWCS Operator I.

Or, any combination of education and experience that shall be substantially equivalent to the above education and experience.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:** At the time of appointment, must possess Class II Chauffeur license and/or other equipment operators license as required.
